### Month of Holy Souls

Next month, November is traditionally the time when we remember and pray for those who have died, and recall that they pray for us.

From next Sunday, there will be baskets placed before the statues of Our Lady in each church into which people can place prayers for those they wish to be remembered and prayed for in the November masses.

Each mass offered in November will be offered as normal for a specific intention—a person or persons, or a cause— but all those whose names have been placed in the baskets will be remembered in the prayers.

To have a November mass offered for a specific person or group of people who have died, please fill in one of the brown mass intention envelopes at the back of each church and place it in the collection at a weekend mass.

The intentions for the November masses tend to be taken quite early, so if a mass cannot be offered in November we will schedule it for December. Put your contact details on the brown envelopes so we can let you know when the masses are to be offered.
